



In order to ensure the best and safest experience possible, all Box Concerts bookings require:

- Space for parking in front, beside, or behind your building no less than 10 feet wide x 25 feet long (roughly 2 parking spaces)
- The capacity for residents to safely move from their rooms to the outdoor audience viewing space or the ability to open their windows
- Space for a socially distanced audience no less than 16 feet from the Box Stage parking space
- A grounded power outlet. If you have a long extension cord that would be really helpful, but not necessary.

### How much does it cost?

We value our health care professionals, so Box Concerts are free for care homes and hospitals.

Individuals and charitable foundations are welcome to contribute to help cover the cost via our supporter page.

### What are the safety protocols?

The host must ensure there is space for a socially distanced audience no less than 16 feet from the Box Stage parking space in advance. The host is also responsible for ensuring audiences remain socially distanced at all times and that they adhere to any public guidelines for safety.

### How long does a Box Concert last?

About 30 minutes.

### What if it rains?

We will give you a call to rearrange your concert for a later date.

### What will happen on the day?

We will have shared contact information for the coordinator and the driver-technician and confirmed the time and location of the performance and your institution's contact in advance. The Box Concerts team will arrive 30 minutes before the concert start time to park the trailer stage, meet the contact(s) and set-up the stage. The team is two people: the performer and the driver-technician. We ask that the contact(s) wear masks and observe social distancing when interacting with our artist and crew.

Set up takes between 15 and 20 minutes. It involves opening the box, plugging in the equipment to the outlet you provide, and doing a quick soundcheck.
