



ALL BOX CONCERTS BOOKINGS REQUIRE

- Space for parking in front, beside, or behind your building no less than 10 feet wide x 25 feet long (roughly 2 parking spaces)
- Space for a socially distanced audience no less than 16 feet from the Box Stage parking space
- A grounded power outlet. If you have a long extension cord that would be really helpful, but not necessary.
- That the host ensures that all audience members remain socially distanced for the duration of the concert

FAQS

How do I book?

You can book a private performance on our website. Once your booking is confirmed, our Box Office team will be in touch within 2 business days to answer any questions.

How much does it cost?

A private Box Concert costs **\$250 + HST**.

If you organize with 10 neighbors, that's only \$25 each!

What will happen on the day?

The Box Concerts team will arrive 30 minutes before the concert start time to park the trailer stage, meet the host(s) and set-up. The team is two people: the performer and the driver-technician. We ask that the host(s) wear masks and observe social distancing when interacting with our artist and crew.

Set up takes between 15 and 20 minutes.

How long does the show last?

About 30 minutes.

What if it rains?

We will give you a call to rearrange your concert.

Where do I sit?

On your front porch, on your driveway, on your doorstep. Sit wherever you like, as long as you can stay a safe distance from other audience members not in your household.

The host should make sure the audience sits no less than 16 feet from the Box Stage parking space. The host is also responsible for ensuring the audience remains socially distanced throughout the show and observes any other government mandated safety measures.
