

WOMEN IN MUSICAL LEADERSHIP



Created and led by Tapestry Opera, **Women in Musical Leadership (WML)** is a three-year fellowship that collectively develops the next generation of women and non-binary conductors in Canada. Tapestry Opera started the WML program in 2020 to redress the gender imbalance of musical leadership in major organizations nationwide.

As of 2020, less than 5% of hired conductors and 15% of titled music directors in Canada are women. Along with lead partner Pacific Opera Victoria and lead orchestral partner the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, Tapestry leverages an impressive network of 25 partner organizations to facilitate placements, mentorship for the conductors and support opportunities to hone their skills on podiums nationwide.

Centrally located at 877 Yonge Street, within walking distance from five diverse neighbourhoods and two TTC hubs, all spaces will be fully accessible. Tapestry Opera will offer rental subsidies for independent and emerging artists to support the next generation of creators and free community programming for the neighbourhood.

This new performing arts facility will be the most flexible, accessible and well-equipped theatre of its size in Toronto.
